Shortly after publication of “Debunking Rhaeto-Romance: Synchronic Evidence from Two Peripheral Northern Italian Dialects” (De Cia & Iubini-Hampton 2020), the authors noticed a typographical mistake in Table 1 in relation to the Friulian phonetic transcription of the word ‘key’. The correct transcription of the Friulian word *clâf* ‘key’ is [kla:f].
